



Ladybug Crackers




Ingredients:

Covered with WIC Checks	Grape tomatoes
Other	Crackers Black Olives Fresh Chives Black Pepper (or other seasoning for ladybug spots) Cream Cheese

Directions

1. Spread cream cheese on crackers
 2. Cut grape tomatoes in half then cut a small slit in each half
 3. Cut Olives in half twice (lengthwise then vertical)
 4. Place olive and tomato on crackers
 5. Slice chives a centimeter long and place between them the tomato and olive
 6. Sprinkle on black pepper, or other seasoning on tomatoes to make ladybug spots
- Decorate cracker with fresh herbs (optional)
